


Alternate Directions During XFC Full-Scale Air Show

Please note that during the airshow portion of XFC, certain restrictions will be in place in order to comply with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations (**highlighted area**). From 11:30 a.m. until the completion of the airshow (2 p.m. at the latest), the following roads will be closed: Aeromodeler's Blvd, the primary road at the entrance to the AMA off Memorial Drive; County road (CR) 400 at the intersection of Memorial and 400, and approximately ¼ mile south of the intersection with Smithfield Pike; and Smithfield pike roughly ½ mile east of CR 400.

Visitors and vendors coming from Muncie during that time window are advised to go right on Cecil Road (just before you pass the EMT station) and follow (**green arrows**) it until it ends at Inlow Springs Road; go left on Inlow Springs and go approximately 1 mile and turn left on CR 388 East. Follow this road past Reese Airport and later a cemetery on the left, accessing the AMA property through the yellow gate which will remain open throughout the event.
